



Composting



A year ago, the campsite adopted a simple but extremely effective solution: composting. This eco-responsible gesture transforms our organic waste into precious resources, while preserving the nature that surrounds us.

The campsite is a special place where nature is at the heart of the experience. By composting our waste, we help to preserve the green spaces around us, nourish the earth and encourage local biodiversity. Nutrient-rich compost helps improve soil quality and supports plant growth.

But the benefits don't stop there: composting also reduces the amount of waste sent to landfill. This reduces the ecological footprint of the campsite, a simple but essential gesture for our planet.

We have put in place simple and practical solutions to make composting easier, both for campers on bare pitches and for those staying in our rental accommodation.

For each camper staying in a bare pitch, we offer them a fully biodegradable kraft bag, which can be used to deposit their organic waste. This bag can then be thrown directly into the compost bins that we have installed in several strategic locations around the campsite, to make composting accessible to everyone.

What's more, there's a bioswale in every rental unit. This handy little composter makes it easy to separate your waste during your stay.
